

JOSEPH B. KIRKISH, Ph.D. PHI KAPPA TAU EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Copper Shores Community Health Foundation (CSCHF) has established the Joseph B. Kirkish, Ph.D. Phi Kappa Tau Educational Scholarship award for eligible Brothers of the Phi Kappa Tau Fraternity, Hancock, Michigan / Michigan Technological University Chapter. CSCHF will award two (2) \$2,500 scholarships to members of the fraternity. The scholarship is a one-time award to be expended in the 2025-2026 academic year. The successful recipient will meet the below-referenced criteria and submit their application to CSCHF who will anonymously review the finalist applications to make an award decision.

Eligibility Criteria:

- At the donor's request, the student must be a Brother of the Phi Kappa Tau Fraternity, Hancock, Michigan / Michigan Technological University Chapter (provide proof of membership in good standing);
- The student must have at least a 2.5 GPA;
- The student must be intending to seek an undergraduate degree;
- The student must be enrolled full-time at Michigan Technological University (at least 12 credits), the student must attend both fall and spring semesters;
- The student must demonstrate engagement in school and/or community activities; and
- The student must write a cover letter and accompanying essay in support of their application.

This scholarship is a one-time award to be expended in the Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 academic year (the award will be applied equally between the two semesters). The applicant must meet the above-referenced criteria and submit their application to the Copper Shores Community Health Foundation. Applications will be redacted to ensure unbiased review by the committee, which will review the finalist applications and make an award decision.

Important Dates:

 The student must submit a completed application to the Copper Shores Community Health Foundation. Applications must be postmarked, emailed or delivered to CSCHF Office no later than March 7, 2025 to be considered. <u>All required documentation must be included at the time of application submission, incomplete applications will not be considered</u>. - Describe a meaningful volunteer experience and how it impacted you;
- Describe ways in which you have demonstrated being a good citizen, and;
- Describe ways in which you strived to attain the ideals of Phi Kappa Tau and brought honor and credit to the fraternity.

Students must submit completed applications to the Copper Shores Community Health Foundation. Applications must be postmarked, emailed, or delivered to CSCHF Office no later than **March 7, 2025**, to be considered. *Incomplete applications will not be considered*.
